#### **Outreach Vehicles (F1 - F5)**

### Library Staff (J1- J09)

Report figures as of the last day of the fiscal year. Include all positions funded in the library's budget whether those positions are filled or not. To ensure comparable data, 40 hours per week has been set as the measure of full-time employment (FTE). For example, 60 hours per week of part-time work by employees in a staff category divided by the 40-hour measure equals 1.50 FTEs.

#### To calculate FTEs for seasonal workers, I would use the following example:

- Two three month workers (.25 of year) work 15 hours a week, so
- 15 + 15 = 30 hrs/wk
- 30/40 = .75 FTEs
- .75 \* .25 = .1875 FTE for entire year (based on working only three months)
